

PLAYING WITH PAINTSTIKS ½ DAY WORKSHOP

Remember when you were in kindergarten, and you put a leaf or penny under a piece of paper, then rubbed the crayon on top of the paper? An image of the leaf or penny magically appeared on the sheet. That's exactly the idea with Shiva Oil Paintstik rubbings. Students will create their own unique embellished fabrics using Paintstiks with batik stamps. The completed fabric will be completely washable and colorfast.

Length: 3 hour

Level: All Levels

NOTE: The instructor will bring a wide variety of copper batik stamps for “Play” with the Paintstiks. She also provides an ample supply of paintstiks for class use. Copper Stamps and Paintstiks will also be available for purchase at the workshop.

Paintstik Workshop Student Supply List

~ Fabric to work on: Small pieces of fabric to experiment with - these can be as small as 6” square or up to fat quarter size. If you have some old “Uglies” bring them to practice on. Bring lights and darks - the rubbings show up best on fabrics that read like solids or hand-dyed fabric. This can be cotton, silk, or synthetic.

~ Also bring some larger pieces of fabric that will be keepers.

~ Newspaper or plastic to cover table or small floor area to set your items to dry

~ Paper towels

~ Rubber Gloves (optional). Wipes are handy to have available

~ Masking tape

~ Wear old clothes or bring an apron. The paint can be easily removed from skin but not from clothes.

The instructor will provide all of the paintstiks and batik stamps for you to use during the class.
